On Friday, January 5, 2018, S.A.F.E (Sexual Assault and Family Emergencies) will be presenting a program to your child's classroom on Body Safety and Bullying. The presentation is age appropriate and defines "private parts" as the parts of the body covered by a bathing suit. The main goal of our presentation is to educate our children and empower them to deal effectively with sexual abuse. The information presented teaches three main points: **1) Say no or Stop, 2) Get away to a safe place, and 3) enlist the help of a trusted adult.** We welcome and encourage parents to attend the presentation.

S.A.F.E is a non-profit organization that helps the victims of sexual assault, their families and friends. S.A.F.E.'s crisis center's include counselors, educators, medical and legal advocates and support staff that provide services for free of charge.
